



2011 Minnesota Boat Club Volunteer Requirement

Because annual dues cover only a fraction of the Boat Club's expenses, MBC relies heavily on member participation. Most of our members already give generously of their time and talent, and we want to encourage and foster that spirit in ALL of our members. This formal Volunteer Requirement is modeled on programs already in use by clubs around the country.

How it Works

Each member will pay a \$50 Volunteer Deposit with his/her dues. Throughout the season members can earn points for the work they do around or for the Boat Club. Once people have earned 20 points they can send in their completed Volunteer Form to receive their deposits back.

We encourage you to earn your points, complete the form and submit it before the end of the current MBC membership year, March 31, 2012. Otherwise, your \$50 volunteer deposit will become part of the Club's general operating fund when the new membership year starts on April 1, 2012.

Earning Points

You can earn 1 point per hour for anything that improves or maintains the Boat Club, including: sweeping, gardening, washing towels, helping with the dock, general "work parties", stocking the band-aids or batteries, taking trash or recycling home, maintaining the ergs...or anything else that you believe has value!

Earn double points (2 points per hour) for things that bring money in to the Club (like assisting with MBC School of Rowing, or picking up debris on Robert Street, etc), or taking on a non-paying position of leadership (like coaching, working on a club committee or serving on the Board).

We realize that many of you will earn your 20 points in just a few weeks...and then hopefully keep on giving!
